DAYS 1, 2 & 3 - CATHEDRAL PEAK HOTEL

Your flight to King Shaka International is the start of your Drakensberg Adventure. In Durban, you will meet your guide and set off to Cathedral Peak Hotel and into the 'Berg'.

The well-known Cathedral Peak Hotel - a perennial favourite among lovers of the 'Berg'. The hotel is beautifully situated in the Drakensberg foothills, with impressive vistas over mountains and valleys. Indoor activities include table tennis, a games room, a fully equipped gym with a steam bath, and a beauty therapist where you are encouraged to relax and be pampered. Outdoor leisure activities include walking, bowls, outdoor chess, fly fishing, and an immaculate 9-hole golf course. DAYS 4 & 5 - GIANTS CASTLE

Giant's Castle Game Reserve lies in the Central 'Berg region of the Ukhahlamba Drakensberg Park. Its name comes from the silhouette of the mountain escarpment that resembles the profile of a sleeping giant. Our camp, situated on a grassy plateau among deep valleys that run downward from the face of the High 'Berg, offers glorious vistas of the surrounding landscapes.

During our stay, you may choose to join short group walks to view sites, or of course, you could just enjoy the views from the camp. The Main Caves Bushman Museum is a one-hour walk from the camp. Although it is a moderately challenging walk, anybody who is walking fit and determined can do it. The caves house one of the largest galleries of stone-age art in the Drakensberg, spanning several thousands of years. The prolific bird life is also an attraction.

DAY 6 - MIDLANDS MEANDER

Leaving Giant's Castle, we enjoy a journey along the well-known 'Midlands Meander'. Many artists and crafters of all disciplines have settled here, and we will have an opportunity to visit several interesting studios and shops. Apart from enjoying the work on display and meeting some of the characters who live and work here, it is also an opportunity to shop for unique gifts. Tonight, we stay in a quiet country guesthouse in the Midlands.

DAY 7 - MANDELA CAPTURE SITE AND HOMEWARD BOUND

Heading southward, we visit the Nelson Mandela Capture site near Howick and later arrive at King Shaka Airport where we wing our way back to our destination, where a company representative will be waiting to whisk you safely home.
