Classic Kruger

This exciting 7-day safari focuses on the wild and wonderful Kruger National Park. One of Africa's largest and oldest national parks, it has been a protected area since 1898. On our daily game drives, we will have a good chance of encountering the 'Big Five' - but there is so much more to this wilderness, such as the abundant bird life and smaller intriguing animals.

DAY 1 - NELSPRUIT AND KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

You will be picked up from your home or hotel and taken to the airport, where you will meet with your fellow travelers. We fly to Nelspruit, and from there, we set forth in our minibus to Kruger National Park, traveling eastwards into the heart of the Lowveld, with its subtropical climate and typical bushveld vegetation. Around midday, we arrive at the park, where we will have lunch. Afterward, we will have some free time to settle and enjoy the natural surroundings. The chalets are rustic but comfortable, and meals are at park restaurants.

CAMP DAYS 2-6 - EXPLORING THE PARK

We spend the next five days on morning and afternoon game drives, exploring all that Kruger has to offer. We follow the same pattern of relaxed game-viewing experiences—the longer one spends in the bush, the luckier one gets with interesting sightings! Leaving our first camp, we head northwards on a game drive to our next camp, pausing en route to enjoy the varied animal sightings and take our time looking at the finer details of the ecology. We travel through different eco-zones, with vegetation ranging from mopani forest to grasslands and riverine bush. The tracks along the winding and tree-lined rivers are a scenic wonderland and well worth exploring.

Departing our second camp, we head southward to our last stop. Here we explore Southern Kruger and the winding roads along the Timbavati River. Large herds of elephants are frequently seen having a drink and a bath, providing plenty of entertainment. This is an area that offers surprises around nearly every bend, and we make the most of our time in the bush.

Evening game drives in an open vehicle are an optional extra. This will offer the opportunity to spot nocturnal animals like aardvarks, porcupines, or even some of the larger predators on the move.

DAY 7 - HOMEWARD BOUND

Today, we have an early departure for Nelspruit and our flight home. As usual, our company representatives will be at hand to assist in delivering you safely to your doorstep.
